



# The Ideal Village as the Path Forward



Pandemic has reminded us we live in a "Global Village"

Communities and countries are mutually dependent.

Climate change, pandemics and natural disasters do not respect (manmade) national boundaries. Inequities in society seem to getting worse.

Almost two-thirds of the world's population lives in rural areas, with limited or no access to the essential needs of human existence. Unconstrained urban development models and consumptive lifestyles have created risk scenarios:
